

Observer Agreement



-
1. Observers are expected to adhere to all the same bylaws and agreements that MOPS members do.
 2. It is also expected that an Observer will not interfere with an investigation in any manner. This includes, but is not limited to: Falsifying evidence by way of making sounds, moving equipment, claiming to hear/see things they do not or providing false information of the property being investigated.
 3. MOPS is not responsible for Observers injury, death, or other personal loss.
 4. Observers agree to not operate any equipment without explicit authorization from a MOPS member. However, an Observer can bring their own flashlight and camera if they wish.
 5. An Observer is not required to stay for a full investigation and can leave when they want. Frequent leaving and coming back during an investigation (restroom break, making phone calls, etc) is very discouraged as it creates too many possibilities for evidence contamination.
 6. MOPS and the Property Owner/Location Representative reserve the right to ask an Observer to leave at their own discretion.
